AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This revision has been filed against the order dated 12.02.2016 declining interim directions to the respondent to permit the petitioner to make '*minor repairs*' on the roof of chaubara.

The Rent Controller noticed that the very same reliefs were the subject of the main petition under Section 12 of the East Punjab Urban Rent Restriction Act filed by the petitioner and since the petitioner did not specify what kind of minor repairs he wanted to carry out the acceptance of the application would amount to grant of main relief sought through petition under Section 12 of the Act.

I see no reason to take a different view to that taken by the Rent

Controller.

Revision petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc.

Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
