Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioner no.1 is deaf and dumb person. He want to sell his property for the marriage of his sister and other *bonafide* needs. He contended that his sale deed is not even registered by the Sub-Registrar, Patran, District Patiala as petitioner is deaf and dumb person. Learned counsel for the petitioners also states that no litigation is pending with respect to the land in question. He has also not executed any agreement to sell in favour of any person except respondent no.4. The petitioner no.1 has already moved the representation (Annexure P-6) to respondent no.2- Deputy Commissioner, Patiala.

The present revision petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2-Deputy Commissioner, Patiala to consider the representation (Annexure P-6) dated 21.08.2015 moved by petitioner no.1 in accordance with law and relevant rules and to pass the speaking order within two months.
