Rekha Mittal, J. I(Oral)

The present petition has been directed against the order dated 24.12.2015 passed by the Additional District Judge, Sangrur whereby the parties have been directed to maintain status quo regarding existing construction of go-downs in question till decision of the application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure (in short, CPC) by the trial Court.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petition may be disposed of but direction may be issued to the trial Court to dispose of the application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC in a time bound manner without being influenced by any observations made in the order impugned.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of without

examining merits of the case. However, the trial Court is directed to dispose of the application for grant of interim injunction within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. The trial Court shall dispose of the application for stay without being influenced by any observations made by the Court in appeal.
