This petition has been filed against the concurrent orders dated 25.11.2014 and 11.2.2016 passed by the learned Courts below evicting the petitioner from the demised premises.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the

petitioner, on instructions, states that the petitioner will not press this petition on merits and will vacate the premises voluntarily on or before 31.05.2017 without forcing the respondent to file an execution petition. He further undertakes to pay upto date arrears of rent, if any, within a period of one month from today.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, has also accepted this offer on the condition that the petitioner will file an undertaking to the above effect before the Executing Court within within one month, with the condition that in the event of any default, this petition should be deemed to be dismissed. He further states that since the petitioner is vacating the premises within one year, the respondent will not insist on claiming any rent from him for the said period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has accepted this condition.

The revision petition is disposed of in the above terms.
