This appeal is one of those cases the record of which was burnt in the fire accident in January, 2011. It was listed for the first time thereafter on 19.02.2014, on which date Mr.Vinod Kumar, Advocate, had appeared for Mr.R.S.Cheema, Advocate, and had undertaken to supply a fresh copy of the paper book within a week from that date. Thereafter, none had appeared for two dates and on November 18, 2014, a coordinate Bench had recorded that notices issued to the counsel for the appellant had been received back with the report that this case does not "belong to him".

Upon direction by this Court to find out the particulars of the parties, the report was that the particulars are no longer available. Thereafter, again the case was listed on 16.03.2015 and 06.04.2015, but none had appeared for the parties. Today again none has put in appearance for the parties.

In the aforesaid circumstances, there is no option but to dismiss the case for want of prosecution.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
