C.M. is allowed as prayed for subject to all just exceptions.

C.M. No22206 CII of 2016 & C.R. No.3130 of 2014

Prayer in C.M. No.22206 CII of 2016 is for withdrawal of the revision petition in the light of the compromise dated 26.10.2016, appended as Annexure A-1 with the application, as entered into between the parties. One of the terms of compromise is that the vacant possession of the demised premises has to be handed over by the petitioners to the respondent on or before 31.12.2016.

Counsel for the parties state that in the light of the compromise referred to above, the petitioners do not want to press the present revision petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn in the light of compromise Annexure A-1.

In view of the above and keeping in view the compromise dated 26.10.2016 (Annexure A-1 with the application), the application is allowed and the revision petition is ordered to be withdrawn, as requested in the application. Needless to mention, that the parties will be bound by the terms of the compromise.

Counsel for the parties further state that in the light of the compromise (Annexure A-1), all pending applications have been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of as such. It is so ordered.
