Rekha Mittal, J.

Counsel for the petitioner would contend that the amount of compensation in regard to injuries sustained by Duryodhan @ Jodha was ordered to be deposited in a Fixed Deposit Receipt with the observations that he would be entitled to withdraw the same after furnishing a certificate from the concerned doctor under whose treatment he remained in the DMC and Hospital at Ludhiana regarding his complete recovery.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that Duryodhan @ Jodha has passed away on 26.8.2013, therefore, challenge to the impugned order dated 23.10.2012 has been rendered infructuous and the petition may be disposed of accordingly without prejudice to rights of the legal

heirs of Duryodhan @ Jodha to file an appropriate application for release of the amount.

Disposed of as infructuous.
