The present petition has been filed by the petitioner-plaintiffs for giving direction to the learned trial Court to expeditiously dispose of the application for grant of temporary injunction filed under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (for short CPC).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the service of the defendants is already complete. They have even filed the reply to the stay application. The suit along with stay application was filed in the year 2012. About four years have passed, but the stay application has not been decided so

far.

So, the present revision petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court to make every possible endeavour for expeditious disposal of the application moved by the petitioners under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC preferably within two months.
