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**K.Kannan, J. (Oral)**

Revision petition is liable to be dismissed for the simple reason that the maintenance awarded is an amount of ₹3,500/- to the wife and ₹2,000/- for the son besides ₹5,500/- as litigation expenses. The court has taken note of the fact that even a labourer earns not less than ₹13,000/- to ₹15,000/- per month and has awarded the sum. The counsel states that the wife has already been provided for residence of his ancestral house and he (husband-petitioner) is taking care of one of the sons. The amount awarded in my view is minimal to keep the body and soul together and the petitioner will

earn enough by personal exertion of labour and pay the wife of what is needed as a living provision for a wife and child. I will make no intervention in the revision petition. Revision petition is dismissed.
