Affidavit of petitioner-Khushwinder Singh filed in the Court is taken on record. The petitioner has furnished the details of four schools with their distance from village Jargari, Tehsil Payal, District Ludhiana as well as facility for transportation of school children being available.

Counsel for the respondent has got no objection if the children are admitted to any of the schools mentioned at Serial No.1 to 3 in the affidavit filed by the petitioner but the petitioner should bear the expenses to be paid to the school towards education and transportation and expenses on purchase of uniform and books etc.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to bear all the aforesaid expenses.

Counsel for the parties, on instructions from their clients, are *ad idem* that the children at the first instance would be preferred to be admitted in Delhi Public School, Khanna, District Ludhiana but in case there is some difficulty in their admission in the said school, they would be admitted in Sant Ishar Singh Ji Memorial Public School

Karamsar (Rara Sahib), District Ludhiana. The parents of the children along with the children would approach Delhi Public School, Khanna, District Ludhiana, along with necessary documents for their admission on 29.03.2016. The parents would meet in front of the school at 10 AM.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner would not, in any manner, interfere with custody of the children with the respondent except in accordance with law.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
