SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that as per order passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Kaithal (for short 'the Tribunal'), a part amount of the compensation awarded has been released whereas the remaining amount has been ordered to be deposited in term deposit. It is further submitted that the petitioner is old lady and being a patient of Asthma, requires the entire money for her medical treatment and as such, the balance amount of compensation, lying deposited with 'the Tribunal' be ordered to be paid to her in cash.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, it is ordered that the balance amount of compensation awarded by 'the Tribunal' be paid to the present petitioner along with interest.

The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
