The petitioner is aggrieved of the finding rendered by both the courts below declining the application filed under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC in a suit for permanent injunction and mandatory injunction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in essence, the grievance is with regard to the transfer of the petitioner and in case the injunction sought is not granted the petitioner would suffer irreparable loss and in this regard he has drawn attention of this Court to resolution dated 26.6.2015 (Annexure P-6) of the respondent-bank. He further submits that the suit is at the stage of plaintiff's evidence.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

appraised the paper book.

The injunction sought, in my view, tantamounts to decreeing the suit. The finding rendered by both the courts in declining the application is based upon documentary evidence placed on record and no prima facie, case was found. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek redressal of his grievance by moving an appropriate representation to the Chairman of Sarva Haryana Gramin Bank, Rohtak in pursuance to the resolution mentioned above and in case, any representation is filed, the Chairman shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders uninfluenced by the findings rendered by both the courts below.

With the aforementioned observations, I do not find any illegality and perversity in the impugned order and the same cannot be said to have been passed without jurisdiction.

The revision petition stands disposed of.
