[1]. In this revision petition, petitioner has assailed the order dated 31.05.2016 passed by District Judge, Ludhiana, dismissing the application for transfer of petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act titled as "Sujinder Kaur Vs. Sukhbir Sinigh" from the Court of Additional District Judge, Ludhiana to any other Court of competent jurisdiction in Ludhiana.

[2]. Some imputation regarding conduct of the Presiding Officer was made and ultimately, it was projected that the petitioner has lost faith in the Court. The allegations made against the Presiding Officer were not substantiated by way of affidavit before the District Judge, Ludhiana and that is why the

application came to be dismissed being vague and frivolous.

[3]. During course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to move fresh application before the District Judge, Ludhiana with necessary particulars and seeks withdrawal of this revision petition with a liberty to file fresh application for transfer of case before the District Judge, Ludhiana.

[4]. In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, at this stage, no notice is required to be given to the respondent. This revision petition is allowed to be withdrawn with a liberty to the petitioner to move detailed application before the District Judge, Ludhiana. In case, such an application is moved, District Judge, Ludhiana would be obligated to pass necessary order in accordance with law.

[5] Nothing observed hereinabove would be taken to be an opinion on merits of the transfer application in any manner.
