Learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the instant revision in view of peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case, however, prays that trial court may be directed to decide the suit within a stipulated period.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, trial court is directed to decide the civil suit as early as possible preferably within a period of nine months. Learned trial Court shall afford three opportunities of not more than one month each to the plaintiff and defendants and one opportunity of not more than one month to the plaintiff to lead evidence in rebuttal. No further opportunity

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shall be granted. The witnesses shall be summoned by the parties concerned at their own risk and responsibility. However, they can seek assistance of the Court for summoning the witnesses by dasti process.
