[1]. Perusal of the record reveals that there is some difference in calculation submitted by the land owner vis-a-vis the calculation of the petitioner. Time of more than one year has already elapsed from the date of order/judgment passed by this Court, but the execution as per the calculation of the claimants is still pending.

[2]. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the calculations moved by the either side should be scrutinized and vetted by the Executing Court. In case the calculations submitted by the claimants are ultimately found to be trustworthy, the petitioner would satisfy the award within two

weeks from the date of such satisfaction recorded by the Executing Court.

[3]. Learned counsel further contends that as per Collector's rate and the decision of reference Court, the award stood satisfied by the petitioner before the Executing Court. As per the calculations of the petitioner, the enhanced amount even as per the order of the High Court already stood paid.

[4]. In view of nature of this order which is being passed, this revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the Executing Court to have a look on the calculations made by either side and test the veracity and genuineness of the calculations made within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If the calculations submitted by the claimants are found to be trustworthy, then in that eventuality, the petitioner can be directed to pay the requisite amount within two weeks as undertaken by the petitioner before this Court.

[5]. In view of aforesaid, this revision petition is disposed of. Till then, coercive method evolved by the Executing Court is stayed.
