AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court challenging the dismissal of the application preferred by him for appointment of the Local Commissioner.

Perusal of the order would shows that eight opportunities have already been availed by the petitioner for leading his evidence, who is a tenant and it is at this stage that an application for appointment of Local Commissioner has been filed just to show that the respondent has sufficient accommodation to stay with his family.

The observations of the Court below that the evidence is not to be collected by way of the Local Commissioner and that too at a belated stage, are fully justified and do not call for any interference by this Court.

The revision petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
