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Present petition is directed against the order dated 16.5.2016 (Annexure P-4) passed by Additional District Judge, Ludhiana, whereby application for interim direction was dismissed. The court observed that no injunction needs to be granted regarding alienation as the same would be governed by the rule of *lis pendis*. It also directed that in case any alienation is effected by respondents during the pendency of the appeal, this fact would be reflected in the conveyance deed.

Today, learned counsel for respondents has informed that arguments in the appeal have commenced and the proceedings are likely to culminate soon.

In view of above, I find no ground to interfere in the revisional jurisdiction of this court.
