Rekha Mittal, J.

The present petition has been directed against orders dated 29.1.2013 (Annexure P-3) and dated 7.11.2015 (Annexure P-5) whereby application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure (in short "CPC") filed by respondent No. 1/plaintiff has been allowed and appeal preferred by the petitioners against the said order has been dismissed.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he confines his

prayer only to the effect that any observations made by the Court of Appeal with regard to merits of the controversy may not cause prejudice to rights of the petitioners at the time of disposal of the suit on merits.

As interim injunction was granted by the trial court pending decision of the suit on merits, affirmation of that order by the appellate court but by making observations touching merits of the case would not cause prejudice to the petitioners at the time of final disposal of the suit.

Disposed of accordingly.
