Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the suit was filed by the plaintiff-respondent in the year 2009 and is pending for the last about 7 years. Only one witness of the plaintiff has been recorded so far. He contended that due to delay in the disposal of the case, the petitioner-defendant is suffering irreparable loss as he is not able to raise the construction in his own property. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the present appeal may be disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court to expeditiously dispose of the civil suit.

Thus, the present revision petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court to finally dispose of the civil suit within a period of one year.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also pleaded that some Local Commissioner should have been appointed to

report about the existing position of the disputed property/wall. The petitioner is at liberty to move the application for appointment of a Local Commissioner before the learned trial Court, if, he so desires.
