AMIT RAWAL, J. (ORAL)

The previous order of mine would reveal that this Court also made an attempt for implementation of order, under challenge, even the child was also called, so that, the order of interim custody can be implemented. Even the matter was also sent to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, but nothing concrete came out of it.

This revision is against the order dated 29.02.2016 (Annexure P-1) disposing of the *ad interim* application in a petition filed under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act read with Sections 6 & 13 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, whereby the petitioner-wife has been given right to meet the minor child on 1st, 3rd and 5th Saturday of every month months at ADR Centre from 02.00 P.M. to 04.00 P.M.

Mr. Puneet Jindal, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Mr. Parambir Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner-wife submits that the aforementioned order was not implemented and

therefore, the present revision has been filed. He further submits that the suit is slated for the petitioner's evidence. He further prays for changing of the visiting time to meet the minor child as 12.00 P.M. To 04.00 P.M instead of 02.00 P.M. To 04.00 P.M.

In view of the fact that effort was made by this Court and as well as the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, I deem it appropriate that instead of pondering upon such issue, let the proceedings pending before the Court below under under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act read with Sections 6 & 13 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act be expedited.

Accordingly, the present revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to decide the petition bearing No.86 of 2014 titled as **“Ramanpreet Kaur V/s Harpreet Singh”** under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act read with Sections 6 & 13 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act by giving 3-3 effective opportunities each to the parties as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of four months from the date of the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

However, the visiting time to meet the minor child is hereby changed from 02.00 P.M. to 04.00 PM to 12.00 P.M. to 03.00 P.M.

Revision Petition stands disposed of.
