The present petition directs challenge against order dated 26.04.2016 (Annexure P1) passed by the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Fatehgarh Sahib whereby the respondents/defendants have been provided with an opportunity to file the written statement though earlier defence of the respondents/defendants was struck off.

Counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the fact that one of the defendants in the case Yuvraj Singh is a minor and was sued through his mother and natural guardian Smt. Paramjit Kaur, defendant No. 1.

Keeping in view the fact that interest of the minor would be prejudiced in case the defendants are not permitted to file the written statement, I do not find any reason to interfere in the discretion exercised by the trial Court permitting the defendants to file the written statement and defend the proceedings.

Dismissed.
