ARUN PALLI, J. (ORAL):

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of, only with a direction to the learned trial Court to decide the main case, itself, within a specified time.

Concededly, the petition filed by the petitioner-husband under Section 25 of The Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, was instituted on 16.11.2015, thus, there is hardly anything that warrants any such direction. Needless to assert that the trial Court shall make every endeavour to try and decide the main case itself, particularly, in the wake of its nature, as expeditiously as possible. Petitioner too shall be at liberty to make an appropriate prayer to the trial Court, in this regard.

The petition stands disposed of.
