In an appeal filed by the defendants who are Government, Appellate Court has granted the stay. The grievance of the petitioner-plaintiff is that the Court has not allowed for any security to be given. The Court has considered the fact that the defendants were the Government and that there is no cause for an apprehension that the Government can defeat the rights of the plaintiff even if it is unsuccessful. I find the discretionary order passed by the Appellate Court cannot be lightly interfered with in revision.

The civil revision petition is dismissed.
