AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner has challenged the order of the Rent Controller to the extent that it has appointed one person named Dalbir Singh from the Building Branch of the Estate Office, Chandigarh as Local Commissioner.

It is the contention of the learned counsel that it cannot be for a party to pinpoint a person who is to be appointed as a Local Commissioner.

Notice of motion.

The respondent No.1 has entered appearance in person. He states that he had not named Dalbir Singh out of any extraneous

consideration and would have no objection if any competent person is appointed by the Estate Officer to undertake the duties of the Local Commissioner.

In view of this agreement, the impugned order is modified to the extent that instead of Sh. Dalbir Singh the Local Commissioner would be that official who is nominated by the Estate Officer in this regard. It is however clarified that earlier inspection done by Sh. Dalbir Singh would not be taken into consideration.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
