Counsel for respondents 1 and 2 states that he has no objection if the petitioner is appointed as the Court guardian of Vidya Devi, who has been found to be suffering from organic brain syndrome because of age related impairment.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for respondents 1 and 2, the order dated 01.07.2015 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division)-cum-Rent Controller, Bathinda and the order dated 24.07.2015 (Annexure P-6) passed by the same authority, are set aside and the petitioner is appointed as Court guardian of Vidya Devi.

The revision petition stands disposed of.

In the light of the fact that counsel further agree that there is already a direction for expeditious disposal of the matter pending before the Rent Controller, no further observations are being made herein as it would be mere repetition.
