The challenge in the present writ petition is to the levy of tax on Halwaies. The writ petition was admitted and no interim stay was granted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners had taken the brief from him and they have not responded thereafter.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that the prayer made in the writ petition has been rendered infructuous as vide notification dated 29.12.2005 issued under the Haryana Vat Act, 2003 the Halwaies had been exempted from payment of sales tax.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
