The present petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India giving direction to the learned trial Court for expeditious disposal of the civil suit No. 275 of 2007, titled as Manjit Kaur Vs. Paramjit Singh and others in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the case is pending at the stage of defendants evidence since 06.10.2014 and after that number of opportunities have been availed by the defendants to conclude their evidence. Finally, the evidence of the defendants was closed on 04.05.2015 and the case was posted for rebuttal evidence and arguments. Thereafter, an application for additional evidence was moved by the defendants, which was allowed and again the case started on the evidence of the defendants. Now, the defendants have filed the application for recalling PW-5 Lalit

Sharma. He contended that plaintiff-petitioner is an old lady and more than 75 years of age.

3. In view of the aforesaid contentions, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court to expeditiously dispose of the civil suit mentioned above preferably within six months.
