AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the evidence of the petitioner has been closed by the Court by order dated 25.07.2016. Because of the old age, the petitioner could not appear before the Court nor could she produce her evidence. He states that only one opportunity may be granted to the petitioner to produce and conclude her evidence. A further assertion has been made that the case is listed for arguments on 16.08.2016. He has taken the Court to various zimni orders which have been passed during the course of trial and according to the same, on one of the occasions, the Bar has observed a no work day and, therefore, on other occasions, the defence witnesses could not come present. Although there appears to be reasonable opportunities having been granted to the petitioner to produce her evidence but keeping in view the old age of the petitioner and also that 16 opportunities were granted to the respondent-plaintiff, one opportunity is granted to the petitioner to produce and conclude her evidence on 16.08.2016, the date fixed before the trial Court. This shall be subject to payment of ₹20,000/- as costs to be paid to the

respondents-plaintiffs by the petitioner.

The revision petition stands disposed of accordingly.
