The present petition has been directed against the order dated 31.05.2016 (Annexure P13) passed by Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division) Naraingarh whereby the application filed by the petitioner for dismissal of the execution application, was dismissed.

Perusal of the grounds of revision would make it evident that the petitioner concealed a material fact from the Court that on an earlier occasion, the petitioner filed Civil Revision 1453 of 2016, which was decided by this Court on 05.04.2016. However, with an intent that tomorrow there may not be observations against the petitioner qua concealment of said fact, a copy of the order has been appended at the end of the petition without reference to the earlier proceedings. This apart, perusal of the earlier order would make it evident that even the issue with regard to dismissal of the earlier execution application was adverted to and decided. Every litigant or/and his counsel is expected to disclose material facts to his/their knowledge so that the Court is not kept in dark. In view of the above, the petitioner is not entitled to indulgence of Court as he has approached the Court with unclean hands.

Dismissed in limine.
