1. A third party objection that was disposed of, has the effect of decree under Order 21 Rule 103 CPC since the proceeding is as though it was an adjudication of title in the manner contemplated under Order 21 Rule 101 CPC. The petitioner will, therefore, approach the appropriate forum.
2. The revision petition is disposed of with liberty to the revision petitioner to file an appeal against the order and not a revision petition.
