Rekha Mittal, J.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that an application under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure for recalling order dated 12.7.2016 for permission to examine defendant No. 3 and other evidence of the defendant was sought to be presented before the Court but the same was not entertained. It is further submitted that the said application is not a part of the judicial records. It is prayed that the petition may be disposed of with a directon to the trial court to dispose of the application for recalling order

dated 12.7.2016 by entertaining the application that would be submitted by the petitioner within a period of seven days.

Without commenting upon merits of the controversy, the petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application for recalling order dated 12.7.2016. In case such an application is filed within a period of seven days, the same shall be decided by the trial court after hearing the parties, in accordance with law. within 15 days from the date of its filing.
