The present petition has been directed against order dated 3.8.2016 (Annexure P-6) whereby the Court has refused to accede to the request of the petitioner/plaintiff for early hearing with the observations that 'no short adjournment is possible in the present case'.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application before the trial court for disposal of application under Order 7 Rule 11 of

the Code of Civil Procedure (in short “CPC”) filed by respondent No. 1/defendant and the trial court may be directed to dispose of the said application on the date already fixed.

Without commenting upon merits of the controversy, the petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application before the trial court for disposal of proceedings initiated under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC. In case, such an application is filed, the same shall be disposed of by the trial court on the date already fixed.
