The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to refix the pay of the petitioners at par with the pay of his juniors.

Mr. C.M. Chopra, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in spite of making all efforts, he could not get instructions with regard to present status of the case.
