PARAMJEET SINGH DHALIWAL, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 points out that the case before the trial Court is complete and ripe for arguments. Due to order passed by this Court on 13.09.2013 to maintain status quo regarding possession of the suit land, the case is not being decided. The revision petition arises from an order passed under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC.

Since the case is ripe, the trial Court shall pass the appropriate order in accordance with law and the status quo shall remain in operation only till the passing of the final order by the trial Court. As per zimni order dated 07.11.2015 passed by the trial Court, copy of which has been produced in the Court, the case stands adjourned sine die. In view of this, the case file shall be taken up by the trial Court and appropriate order shall be passed after fixing the date for that purpose and intimating counsel for the parties.

The civil revision is disposed of in above terms.
