Present revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is for setting aside order dated 1.8.2015 [Annexure P/6] passed by Additional Civil Judge [Senior Division], Amritsar in case titled **Nirmal Singh Vs. Sukhdev Singh**, whereby application under Section 28 of the Specific Relief Act, 1963 [for short, "the Act"] was dismissed.
