The petitioner has submitted that he has got no objection in case he is examined as a witness before the trial Court in respect of any document purported to be signed by him as a counsel of Sh. Gurdev Singh – defendant No.6 in the suit. It is further submitted that he is not in possession of any of the documents sought to be produced by him on the basis of application (Annexure R-1/6) and summons (Annexure R-1/7).

Counsel for respondent No.1, in view of the statement made by the petitioner, has submitted that the respondent could not press for production of any documents by the petitioner in the trial Court and examination of the petitioner would be confined to documents signed by him as a counsel for Sh. Gurdev Singh- defendant No.6 and available with the office of Estate Officer, Chandigarh.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
