The present appeal had been filed against the order of acquittal passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar in a complaint under Section 43, 44 read with Section 47 of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974.

The appeal was admitted vide order dated 20.12.2002 with a direction to procure the presence of the respondents through simple notices. The Registry issued notices to the respondents but the same were received back unserved due to incorrect address. Thereafter, several reminders were issued to the counsel for the appellant to furnish correct address of the respondents but no compliance was made. The Registry put up the reference on 26.10.2016 and this Court issued notice to the appellant for 09.12.2016.

Notice issued to the appellant has been received back served with the report that its Environmental Engineer has been transferred to Patiala.

Neither counsel representing the appellant nor any other official representing the appellant is present.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
