Present revision is directed against the order passed by the District Judge, Faridabad, whereby the application filed by the petitioner, who appeared in person, seeking transfer of the case from the Court of Shri Manish Kumar, Additional District Judge, Faridabad, to some other court, as the petitioner has the apprehension that the court would not be impartial in deciding the appeal pending before it, has been dismissed. The prayer has been rejected by the District Judge on the ground that there has to be some reasonable apprehension to support such plea, as taken by the petitioner.

I find no infirmity with the impugned order. The tendency of certain litigants to seek transfer of cases on flimsy grounds has to be strongly discouraged by the courts.

There is no ground to interfere in the revisional jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
