Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner had stated before the learned Civil Judge that although some of the witnesses had been examined, three witnesses, i.e. Khazan Singh, Dharamvir and Sneha Lata, who were stated to be necessary witnesses, could not be examined because they were suffering from illness and their evidence was closed vide order dated 12.09.2016.

He further submits that the petitioners-defendants may be given one effective opportunity to lead their evidence.

Consequently, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 5,000/- to the respondents, one opportunity is granted to the petitioners to examine the remaining witnesses, before the Ld. Civil Judge.

The petition is disposed of.
