Prayer in the present revision is for issuance of a direction to the Executing Court to decide the execution application as early as possible.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had filed a suit for recovery of ₹2.00 lacs which was decreed vide order dated 19.7.2012. Feeling aggrieved, the respondent filed appeal against the said order which was also dismissed vide judgment dated 22.5.2013. Thereafter, the respondent approached this Court by filing Regular Second Appeal No.2154 of 2016 in this Court, in which notice of motion was issued and the recovery beyond ₹1,75,000/- has been stayed. Thereafter, the petitioner filed the execution application before the trial Court on 3.11.2012 and since then the same is lying pending.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the zimni orders placed on record as Annexure P-4 and in agreement with the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner. The

Court cannot keep the execution application pending for such a long period.

There has to be an adjudication as expeditiously as possible, as the execution is of the year 2012.

Accordingly, I dispose of the present revision petition with a direction to the Executing Court to dispose of the execution application as expeditiously as possible.
