AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Challenge in this revision petition is to the order dated 31.03.2015 passed by the Rent Controller, Amritsar, whereby, the petition for eviction preferred by the petitioner was dismissed, appeal against which preferred by the petitioner has also been dismissed by the Appellate Authority, Amritsar, vide order dated 01.09.2016.

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that petitioner had sought the eviction of the respondent from the demised premises and therefore, the eviction should have been ordered in the light of the non-payment of rent. Counsel, thus, contends that the findings as recorded by the authorities below cannot sustain and deserve to be set aside.

I have considered the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner and with his assistance, have gone through the impugned orders but do not find any illegality in the same as both the authorities below have

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properly appreciated the pleadings and the evidence which have been brought on record. Since the petitioner has not been able to prove his case for eviction of the respondent-tenant, the findings as recorded by the authorities below being fully justified do not call for any interference by this Court in exercise of its extra-ordinary jurisdiction of revision.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present revision petition, the same stands dismissed.
