AMIT RAWAL, J. (Oral)

The petitioners are aggrieved of the dismissal of the objection petitions, whereby respondents are seeking execution of the judgment and decree dated 29.01.2010, whereby they have been entitled to assignment of seniority at Sr. No.109 and 109-A.

Mr. Shakti Kaushik, learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners submits that in pursuance to the aforementioned judgment and decree, respondent-plaintiff filed execution application claiming all the benefits i.e. arrears and the seniority and the other benefits but not entitled for arrears as they did not perform their duty. It is in this aspect, objections were filed which have been dismissed by the Court below.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and appraised

the paper book.

Once decree has attained finality at that stage, Execution Court cannot go behind the decree and re-appreciate the contention. Judgment Debtor cannot re-agitate the issue.

No ground for interference is made out.

Accordingly, present revision petition is dismissed.
