The petitioner is aggrieved of the impugned order, whereby application for de-exhibiting the documents which have been wrongly exhibited, has been dismissed.

Mr. Kashish Garg, learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner submits that trial Court has dismissed the application and exhibition should have been kept open and can be decided at the time of final order. He has drawn the attention of this Court to para No.5 of the impugned order.

He submits that in view of the aforementioned findings, exhibition is no longer sustainable.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and appraised the paper book and of the view that order dismissing the application would

not come in the way of the petitioner to raise all the pleas at the time of the arguments vis-a-vis exhibition of the documents in accordance with law.

With the aforementioned observations, impugned order is upheld.

Revision petition is disposed of.
