The prayer in the revision petition is for setting aside the impugned order vide which the evidence of the petitioners has been closed by order. This case was listed in the year 2012 and was adjourned to apprise the court as to what record is available regarding employment and salary of the deceased with the Germany Embassy in India and thereafter the case was adjourned sine die for the reason that the petitioners were seeking perpetual adjournments. After listing of the case, notice had been sent to the counsel for the petitioners but there is no representation even today.

I have gone through the paper book and as well as

the impugned order. Vide order dated 12.10.2012 (Annexure P-3) the learned MACT, Kaithal granted the liberty to the petitioners to examine the witness through appointment of the Local Commissioner. On the next date i.e. 22.10.2012 for not filing the copy of affidavit of the witness in examination-in-chief the evidence of the claimant was closed. There is no status of the matter pending before the trial court.

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts and circumstances, one effective opportunity to lead evidence to the petitioners is granted in pursuance to the order dated 22.10.2012, in case the matter is pending adjudication before the MACT, Kaithal.

Accordingly the impugned order dated 22.10.2012 is set aside. The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the MACT, Kaithal.

The revision petition stands allowed.
