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1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporter or not?

Rekha Mittal, J. (Oral)

Counsel for the petitioner states that the instant petition may be dismissed as withdrawn but the trial Court may be directed to dispose of the suit in a time bound manner.

Counsel for the respondents have got no objection if the trial Court is directed to dispose of the suit within a particular period.

In view of the above, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with a direction to the trial Court to decide the suit within a period of nine months. The petitioner/plaintiff shall be allowed three effective opportunities to adduce evidence within a period of four months. Thereafter the respondents shall be entitled to three effective opportunities in another four months. After conclusion of evidence, the suit would be disposed of within one month. The trial Court shall put its best endeavour to adhere to the time schedule fixed by this Court.
