[1]. Petitioner is aggrieved of order dated 11.08.2016 passed by Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana vide which objections filed by the petitioner were dismissed.

[2]. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in a petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act filed by the petitioner, respondent-wife was awarded interim maintenance to the tune of Rs.10,000/- for herself and Rs.5000/- each for minor children. Against the said order, two revision petitions were filed by both the parties. Both the revision petitions were clubbed and an order dated 06.01.2012 was passed by this Court.

[3]. According to learned counsel for the petitioner, order

dated 06.01.2012 was in respect of claim of respondent-wife also, but the executing Court has not adverted to the import of the order while dismissing the objections filed by the petitioner.

[4]. This revision petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to seek clarification of the order dated 06.01.2012 passed in Civil Revision No.6435 of 2011 and Civil Revision No.7569 of 2011 if so advised. Till 09.11.2016, execution proceedings shall remain stayed.
