The civil revision petition is for amendment which is wholly irrelevant, for, it attempts to change the date of purchase and date of traveling. Admittedly, he had a ticket for 06.06.2013 and he did not travel on that date. Any aspect regarding the date of travel subsequent to the purchase date when it is not an advance reservation is meaningless. The amendment sought cannot advance the case of the petitioner.

After inviting the Court to pass an order, the petitioner wants the withdrawal of the revision.

The civil revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
