Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that mediation proceedings have failed. Vide order dated 16.11.2015, notice was issued to the respondent for examining possibility of an out of Court settlement.

Counsel for the respondent, on the contrary, would submit that the petition for divorce of which the present proceedings are an off-shoot has since been withdrawn and, thus, the present petition otherwise has been rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioner in response has not contested the statement made by counsel for the respondent.

In view of the above, the petition stands dismissed having been rendered infructuous.

An amount of Rs.20,000/- deposited by the petitioner in the Registry shall be released in favour of the respondent, as per rules.
