Rajan Gupta, J.

Present revision petition is directed against the order dated 01.08.2016, passed by the trial court, whereby application preferred by the petitioner/plaintiff No.1, who is residing in USA, to depose by way of video conference, has been rejected.

It has been urged by learned counsel for the petitioner before the court that impugned order is not in conformity with law. There is a provision for video-conferencing. Rejection of the application in this regard would prejudice the case of the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and given careful thought to the facts of the case.

It appears that petitioner alongwith his parents namely, Paramjit Singh Kochhar and Paramjit Kaur Kochhar filed a suit for permanent injunction against the respondents for restraining them from interfering into possession of the plaintiffs or entering into the house in suit bearing No.1453-D, Model Town Extension, Ludhiana. During

pendency of suit, petitioner/plaintiff No.1 filed instant application to depose by way of video conference. Trial court rejected the same. Aggrieved, instant revision has been filed by the petitioner. I am of the considered view that the application is without any merit and has rightly been rejected by the court below. It is inexplicable why petitioner did not prefer to depose in court through his General Power of Attorney namely, Kanwaljit Singh, through whom he has instituted the suit. Thus, the trial court has rightly observed that there is no justification for allowing petitioner to depose by way of video conference. I find no ground to interfere in revisional jurisdiction. The petition is without any merit and is hereby dismissed.
