AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This revision has been filed against the concurrent orders of the Courts below allowing ejectment of the petitioner-tenant from the demised premises.

On 03.02.2016 the following order was passed:-

“After arguing for some time, learned states that the petitioner is running a business in the shop in dispute and if adequate time is granted she would relocate her business and would vacate the premises voluntarily without forcing the landlord to take out execution proceedings.

I find this to be a fair submission.

Notice of motion.

Let the respondents be served through their counsel in the Appellate Court/Executing Court by way of dasti process.

Adjourned to 24.02.2016.

In the meantime, the dispossession of the petitioner shall remain stayed.”

Today the learned counsel for the respondents has accepted the plea of reasonable time with the stipulation that the petitioner files an undertaking before the Executing Court within 15 days that she would vacate the premises voluntarily on or before 30.11.2016 and continue to pay the rent in advance by the 7th of every month and also pays other charges regularly and will also pay the up-to-date arrears of rent within one month from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions has stated that this offer is accepted to him.

Revision petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
